To address these challenges, IACAD partnered with Intalio to develop a Digital Governance Platform built on Intalio.Case. The platform automated core business processes, improved transparency, and provided seamless integration with Microsoft Dynamics 365 and CRM systems, ensuring real-time data synchronization and efficient governance.



Needs and Challenges

IACAD required a comprehensive digital solution to overcome the following challenges:

- Manual processes created inefficiencies and slowed down administrative, technical, and financial operations.
- Financial data management lacked proper tracking mechanisms, making budget allocations and expense monitoring difficult.
- Student records, evaluations, and competition results were scattered across multiple Islamic centers, leading to inconsistencies.
